SCHOOL DISTRICT GOALS AND OBJECTIVES:  
10-YEAR PLAN DEVELOPMENT PROCESS

In accordance with the School Committee's policy on district goals and objectives, the School Committee commits itself to develop, during the calendar year of 2018, a new 10-year plan for the Islesboro Central School. The new 10-year plan will begin with the ICS School Vision Statement developed in 2007-2008 and build on key work that has taken place since the Vision Statement was developed.

The 10-year plan will include input from a variety of stakeholders, including members of the public, parents, school faculty and staff, and board members. The plan will address a variety of issues, including but not limited to: long-term school enrollment; long-term financial stability; student personalized programming; curriculum development; facilities maintenance and improvement; faculty recruitment, development, and retention; community engagement; island housing for families and staff; and sustainability.

The 10-year plan development process will be orchestrated by a sub-committee of the board, and will include the school administration, faculty, staff, and community members. The planning sub-committee will update the full board on a periodic basis during the development of the plan, and will bring to the board's attention any issues that impact the development of the plan.

The School Committee envisions that the new 10-year plan will be completed by the end of calendar year 2018, and will be accompanied by a report from the sub-committee that summarizes the process used to develop the plan, the participants, an overview of meetings, data used in the process, and any issues that the sub-committee believes the board should consider as it weighs implementation of the new 10-year plan.
