

MAGNET SCHOOL PROGRAM

The Islesboro School Committee supports quality education. It is essential to the educational process that sufficient numbers of students attend the Islesboro Central School to provide spirited classroom discussions, appropriate student to student interaction, several points of view and increased student engagement. The School Committee, therefore, shall pursue a course of action to increase the number of attending students by attracting non-resident students in grades 5-12.

A Magnet School Program is hereby established. Non-resident students who wish to pursue an academic diploma may be accepted into the Islesboro Central School. It is the intention of the Islesboro School Committee that this policy will be implemented with the understanding that there will be no net increase in cost to the Island's taxpayers. The administration and staff shall advertise through the appropriate means the excellent academic program of the Islesboro Central School, participate in discussions and interviews with prospective families and otherwise attract students to the school.

Tuition for Magnet Students will be established by April 1 at a rate determined by the Islesboro School Committee.

Application materials shall be approved by the School Committee.
