

ORGANIZATION AND MEETINGS OF THE SCHOOL COMMITTEE

Membership

The Islesboro School Committee shall consist of five (5) members nominated and elected at large by the qualified voters of the town. Only qualified voters of the town shall be eligible.

Election of School Committee Members

- a. The election of School Committee members shall be in accordance with title 20, Maine Revised Statutes.
- b. Election of members to the School Committee shall be for a term of three (3) years.
- c. At each annual town meeting School Committee members shall be elected to fill the positions of those whose terms expire.
- d. In the event that a School Committee member resigns before the expiration of the elected term, the School Committee shall appoint a replacement within 30 days of the date of resignation. The term of office of the appointed member shall expire at the next annual town meeting at which time the vacancy will be filled by the voters.
- e. In the event that a School Committee member resigns before the expiration of the elected term, and the School Committee fails to appoint a replacement within the required 30 days, the School Committee shall petition the Board of Selectmen to hold a special town meeting for the purpose of filling the vacancy.
