

**AUTHORITY AND DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY**

All individuals employed by the School Committee are directly responsible to the Superintendent. The Superintendent shall make rules and give instructions to school employees as may be necessary to satisfy the policies of the School Committee.

The Superintendent may delegate to other employees of the School power to discharge any duties required of the Superintendent by these policies.

The delegation of power or duty, however, does not relieve the Superintendent of responsibility to the School Committee for such duties.
