It is the policy of the Islesboro School Committee to seek to meet the individual needs of all students by providing appropriate programs at Islesboro Central School. However, there are times when a student's needs or interests continue beyond the programming available at ICS. In such cases, the administration is authorized to approve enrollment in alternative school programs. Examples include but are not limited to courses taken through AcademE, Tandberg, the Hutchinson Center, and the Center for Talented Youth.
