

## **STUDENT COMPUTER AND INTERNET USE**

Islesboro Central School provides computers, networks, and Internet access to support the educational mission of the schools and to enhance the curriculum and learning opportunities for students and school staff. The resources available through the Internet are of significant value in the learning process and preparing students for future success. At the same time, the unregulated availability of information and communication on the Internet require that schools establish reasonable controls for lawful, efficient and appropriate use of this technology.

Student use of school computers, networks and Internet services is a privilege, not a right. Students are required to comply with this policy and the accompanying rules. Any student who violates this policy and/or any rules governing use of the school's computers may have their computer privilege revoked and may also be subject to disciplinary action and/or legal action.
