

RECOGNITION OF STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

The Board believes it is important to individual students, the schools, and to the community to recognize the outstanding contributions, achievement and performance of ICS students in such areas as academic accomplishment, vocational/technical achievement, athletics, fine arts, citizenship, leadership, community service, attendance, and/or exemplary courage or behavior. The Board believes that such recognition motivates students, enhances the District's reputation and may increase support for its public schools.

The Board encourages ICS administrators and staff to recognize outstanding student achievement by means such as letters, certificates and commendations; special events; school awards ceremonies; and acknowledgment or awards at graduation.

The Board may recognize outstanding achievement at a regular Board meeting or a special event held for that purpose, through letters, certificates and commendations, or by other means it deems appropriate.
