

ENROLLMENT OF CHILDREN OF NON-RESIDENT ICS TEACHERS AND STAFF

The Islesboro School Committee believes that in order to attract and maintain qualified teachers and staff at the Islesboro Central School, nonresident ICS teachers and staff be allowed to enroll their children at the Islesboro Central School. This enrollment would be open to all grades, K-12, and limited to those circumstances in which students' needs can be met by existing programs and services at the Islesboro Central School.

Admission and continued enrollment of children of nonresident ICS teachers and staff at ICS will be based on the following:

- There are no minimum academic requirements for enrollment;
- Admission will not be limited by size of class;
- Continued enrollment will be based on a student's behavior in meeting the expectations published in the ICS Handbook and related school committee policies.

A committee comprised of the ICS Principal, ICS Guidance Counselor, and one ICS teacher (Islesboro resident) will review the enrollment of nonresident students each year and make a recommendation to the Superintendent for continued enrollment by April 1.

Tuition for nonresident ICS teachers and staff children will be established by April 1 at a rate determined by the Islesboro School Committee.

ICS teachers and staff members are defined as full-time employees, who work during the school day.
